

## June 28, 2021: Construction Update No. 6 Brooklyn Boulevard Reconstruction Project Phase 2

The Brooklyn Boulevard Reconstruction Phase 2 Project continues making progress. Last week, the contractor (Park Construction) removed abandoned pipes and replaced aging water and sanitary service components. See below for more information about the upcoming construction schedule.



## Construction activity for this week:

- Brooklyn Blvd from Bass Lake Road to 63<sup>rd</sup> Ave is back open.
- Closure of the east side of 59<sup>th</sup> Ave & Brooklyn Blvd intersection for pavement reconstruction. Closure will begin Monday, June 28<sup>th</sup> and last for approximately 2 weeks.
- Installation of stormwater drainage system begins.

## Construction activity for the following week:

- Installation of stormwater drainage system continues.
- Reconstruction of east side of 59<sup>th</sup> Ave intersection continues, including installation of aggregate base, pavement, and curb and gutter.



Keep children away from the construction. Construction activity and machinery can often attract the attention of curious children. Your assistance in directing your children away from construction areas is appreciated. Construction vehicles can move quickly and suddenly. Please stay clear of machinery and construction stockpiles and trenches.
