

iMS Software

Community Development has a new permit and rental licensing software, Intuitive Municipal Solution, iMS. There are many different features that the software offers which will allow users to track the rental process.



All rental property owners and managers are encouraged to register for an account and start tracking individual rental licenses.

In the iMS software you will be able to:

- 1. Track rental license progress
- 2. Receive email notices and communication regarding rental license status and requirements
- 3. Schedule rental license inspections
- 4. Be able to see other code violations
