

April 18th, 2022: Construction Update No. 28 Brooklyn Boulevard Reconstruction Project Phase 2

The Brooklyn Boulevard Reconstruction Phase 2 Project has begun the 2022 construction season. This year, the contractor, Park Construction, will complete the project work in Stage 2 (see below for description of Stages), which includes reconstruction of the west side of Brooklyn Blvd, reconstruction of medians, and realignment of Admiral Ln at Brooklyn Blvd. Last week the contractor removed pavement and out-of-use storm sewer lines.



Construction activity for this week:

• The intersection of Brooklyn Blvd and 61st Avenue is closed for the installation of storm sewer and is planned to be back open by May 2nd.

Construction activity for the following week:

- Continue storm sewer and water service installation.
- The intersection of Brooklyn Blvd & 61st Avenue is planned to re-open May 2nd.



<u>Keep children away from the construction.</u> Construction activity and machinery can often attract the attention of curious children. Your assistance in directing your children away from construction areas is appreciated. Construction vehicles can move quickly and suddenly. Please stay clear of machinery and construction stockpiles and trenches.

Safety is always our highest concern during the construction of these types of projects. Please slow down through the construction zone for the safety of others, and the workers on site, as well as your own safety. Thank you for your consideration and patience.
