

May 4, 2022: Construction Update No. 3 Woodbine Area Reconstruction Project Project Nos. 2022-01, 02, 03, & 04

The Contractor has completed tree removals, curb removals and sidewalk removals in stage 1.

This week's (5/2-5/6) work in stage 1 will include the following activities:

- Connection of homes to temporary water system
- Installation of new gas mains by CenterPoint Energy

Next week's (5/9-5/13) work will include the following activities:

- Begin hydrant and water shut off replacements in Stage 1
- Installation of new gas mains by CenterPoint Energy in Stage 2
- Installation of new gas services by CenterPoint Energy in Stage 1.
- Begin concrete work on curb and sidewalk replacements and new sidewalk on 71st Ave and 73rd Ave in Stage 1.

<u>Keep children away from the construction.</u> Construction activity and machinery can often attract the attention of curious children. Your assistance in directing your children away from construction areas is appreciated. Construction vehicles can move quickly and suddenly. Please stay clear of machinery and construction stockpiles and trenches.

Personal property located within the construction limits will likely be impacted as part of the project. The Contractor will salvage & reinstall hardscape materials, but the City does not replace any small plants or shrubs impacted by the work.

Please remove any items of sentimental value as the City cannot guarantee that they won't be damaged by the construction process. If you have a sprinkler system or invisible fence, please contact the Engineering Division and let us know.
