

## June 6<sup>th</sup>, 2022: Construction Update No. 35 Brooklyn Boulevard Reconstruction Project Phase 2

The Brooklyn Boulevard Reconstruction Phase 2 Project continues work for the 2022 construction season. This year, the contractor, Park Construction, will complete the reconstruction of the west side of Brooklyn Blvd, including the center medians and realignment of Admiral Ln at Brooklyn Blvd. Last week, the contractor finished placing pieces for the underground stormwater storage tank at 63<sup>rd</sup> Ave.



## Construction activity for this week:

- The west side of the Brooklyn Blvd & 63<sup>rd</sup> Ave will be closed for 2 weeks beginning Saturday, June 11<sup>th</sup> to complete the installation of the stormwater system.
- The west side of the Brooklyn Blvd & Admiral Ln will be closed for 2 weeks beginning Saturday, June 11<sup>th</sup> to complete the installation of the stormwater system.
- The underground stormwater storage tank at the northwest corner of Brooklyn Blvd & 63<sup>rd</sup> Ave will be connected to the new stormwater system.
- Continue installation of the street lights and concrete medians between 59<sup>th</sup> Avenue and 63<sup>rd</sup> avenue.

## Construction activity for the following week:

- The west side of the Brooklyn Blvd & 63<sup>rd</sup> Ave is planned to be re-opened by Saturday, June 25<sup>th</sup>.
- The west side of the Brooklyn Blvd & Admiral Ln is planned to be re-opened by Saturday, June 25<sup>th</sup>.

Your assistance in directing your children away from construction areas is appreciated. Construction vehicles can move quickly and suddenly. Please stay clear of machinery and construction stockpiles and trenches.
