

June 27th, 2022: Construction Update No. 38 Brooklyn Boulevard Reconstruction Project Phase 2

The Brooklyn Boulevard Reconstruction Phase 2 Project continues work for the 2022 construction season. The contractor, Park Construction, will complete the reconstruction of the west side of Brooklyn Blvd, including the center medians and realignment of Admiral Ln at Brooklyn Blvd. Last week, the contractor paved and re-opened 63rd Ave and Admiral Ln.



Construction activity for this week:

- The west side of the Brooklyn Blvd & 63rd Ave intersection is back open.
- The intersection of Brooklyn Blvd & Admiral Ln is back open.
- Preparation for the paving of the trail on the west side of Brooklyn Blvd will take place.
- Work will continue for the signal and lighting systems.

Construction activity for the following week:

- Paving of Brooklyn Blvd north of 63rd Ave will take place.
- Work will continue for the signal and lighting systems.

Your assistance in directing your children away from construction areas is appreciated. Construction vehicles can move quickly and suddenly. Please stay clear of machinery and construction stockpiles and trenches.
