

July 18th, 2022: Construction Update No. 41 Brooklyn Boulevard Reconstruction Project Phase 2

The Brooklyn Boulevard Reconstruction Phase 2 Project continues work for the 2022 construction season. The contractor, Park Construction, will complete the reconstruction of the west side of Brooklyn Blvd, including the center medians and realignment of Admiral Ln at Brooklyn Blvd. Last week, the contractor paved Brooklyn Blvd north of 63rd Ave and the trail on the west side. They also worked on concrete items like curb, maintenance strip, and bus pads.



Construction activity for this week:

- Paving of the second layer of trail on the west side of Brooklyn Blvd will take place on Monday, July 18th.
- Concrete pedestrian ramps on the west side of Brooklyn Blvd will be installed.
- Work will continue for the signal and lighting systems.

Construction activity for the following week:

- Concrete will be poured for the inside median of Brooklyn Blvd.
- Work will continue for the signal and lighting systems.



Keep children away from the construction. Construction activity and machinery can often attract the attention of curious children. Your assistance in directing your children away from construction areas is appreciated. Construction vehicles can move quickly and suddenly. Please stay clear of machinery and construction stockpiles and trenches.
