

August 1st, 2022: Construction Update No. 43 Brooklyn Boulevard Reconstruction Project Phase 2

The Brooklyn Boulevard Reconstruction Phase 2 Project continues work for the 2022 construction season. The contractor, Park Construction, will complete the reconstruction of the west side of Brooklyn Blvd, including the center medians and realignment of Admiral Ln at Brooklyn Blvd. Last week, the contractor worked on the boulevards and pedestrian ramps.



Construction activity for this week:

- The remaining trail on the west side of Brooklyn Blvd will be paved Monday, August 1st.
- Bituminous driveway tie-ins will be completed Monday, August 1st.
- The remaining concrete sidewalk will be placed Friday, August 5th and Saturday, August 6th.

Construction activity for the following week:

- Traffic is anticipated to be shifted to the outside lanes of Brooklyn Blvd beginning Monday, August 8th so that the inner median work can be completed.
- Begin installation of center median curb and gutter followed by the installation of the concrete maintenance stripe.

Stage 1 – 2021 Season: Reconstruction eastside of Brooklyn Blvd 59th Ave N and 65th Ave N.

Stage 2 – 2022 Season: Reconstruct westside of Brooklyn Blvd between 59th Ave N and 65th Ave N. Realign Admiral Ln N at Brooklyn Blvd to align with 60th Ave N.



Keep children away from the construction. Construction activity and machinery can often attract the attention of curious children. Your assistance in directing your children away from construction areas is appreciated. Construction vehicles can move quickly and suddenly. Please stay clear of machinery and construction stockpiles and trenches.
