

September 12th, 2022: Construction Update No. 49 Brooklyn Boulevard Reconstruction Project Phase 2

The Brooklyn Boulevard Reconstruction Phase 2 Project is making progress and nearing its final tasks. Last week, the contractor (Park Construction) installed the remaining concrete for the project, including the new sidewalk along Admiral Ln.



Construction activity for this week:

- The preparation for and laying of sod will begin.
- Landscaping work will continue.
- Work will continue for the new signal and lighting systems.

Construction activity for the following week:

- Work will continue for the new signal and lighting systems.
- Signposts will begin installation.
- The paving of the final layer of asphalt along Brooklyn Blvd is scheduled to begin Monday, September 19th.
