

September 19th, 2022: Construction Update No. 50 Brooklyn Boulevard Reconstruction Project Phase 2

The Brooklyn Boulevard Reconstruction Phase 2 Project is making progress and nearing its final tasks. Last week, the contractor (Park Construction) began placing sod along the west side of Brooklyn Blvd.



Construction activity for this week:

- Sod will continue to be placed.
- Work will continue for the new signal and lighting systems.
- Signposts will begin installation.
- The paving of the final layer of asphalt along Brooklyn Blvd is scheduled to begin Thursday, September 22nd.

Construction activity for the following week:

- The final striping will be completed along Brooklyn Blvd.
- Final details and cleanup will be worked on.
- The contractor is aiming to have all lanes open in their final configuration by Friday, September 30th, with small exceptions that may be needed for punch list items.



<u>Keep children away from the construction.</u> Construction activity and machinery can often attract the attention of curious children. Your assistance in directing your children away from construction areas is appreciated. Construction vehicles can move quickly and suddenly. Please stay clear of machinery and construction stockpiles and trenches.

Safety is always our highest concern during the construction of these types of projects. Please slow down through the construction zone for the safety of others, and the workers on site, as well as your own safety. Thank you for your consideration and patience.
