


## September 26<sup>th</sup>, 2022: Construction Update No. 51 Brooklyn Boulevard Reconstruction Project Phase 2

The Brooklyn Boulevard Reconstruction Phase 2 Project is nearing completion. This will be the last weekly update. Last week, the contractor (Park Construction) paved the final layer of asphalt along Brooklyn Blvd, installed sign poles, placed benches and trash cans, and completed landscaping details.



## Construction activity for this week:

- Work will be completed for the new signal and lighting systems.
- Trees will be installed along Brooklyn Blvd.
- The remaining sod and asphalt will be placed along Admiral Ln.
- Striping will occur throughout the week.

## Construction activity for the following week:

• The contractor is aiming to have the project complete and all lanes open in their final configuration, with small exceptions that may be needed for punch list items.



Keep children away from the construction. Construction activity and machinery can often attract the attention of curious children. Your assistance in directing your children away from construction areas is appreciated. Construction vehicles can move quickly and suddenly. Please stay clear of machinery and construction stockpiles and trenches.
