

### Street and Drainage Improvements

- Pavement Reclamation and Replacement
- Spot Curb and Gutter Replacement
- Storm Sewer Spot Replacement
- Casting Replacement

#### **Utility Improvements**

- Sanitary Sewer Lining with Spot Replacement
- Casting Replacement
- Watermain Replacement
- Hydrant and Gate Valve Replacement

### Project Summary – Streets, Storm, Lighting

#### **Street and Drainage Improvements**

- Pavement was last reconstructed in 1996
- Roadway widths will remain at 30 feet
- Curb inspected, spot replacement as necessary
- Existing storm sewer pipes are 6"-12"
- Constructed between 1956 and 1996

### Proposed Improvements

- Pavement reclamation and replacement
- Spot curb and gutter replacement
- Storm sewer spot replacement
- Casting replacement

### Lighting Improvements

- Existing lighting owned by Xcel in the project area
- Lighting exists at intersections and mid-blocks approx. every 700'



## Project Summary – Water & Sanitary

#### Watermain Improvements

- Installed between 1956 and 1996
- Existing pipes are 6"-12"

#### Proposed Improvements

- Watermain replacement in older sections
- Hydrant and gate valve replacement

#### **Sanitary Sewer Improvements**

- Installed between 1956 and 1996
- Existing pipes are 8"-12", with some larger collector pipes
- Televising and condition surveys taken of sewer and manholes

#### Proposed Improvements

- Sanitary sewer lining
- Root intrusion sawing and spot replacement at sags
- · Manhole casting adjustment and replacement











### **Project Impacts**

#### **Tree Impacts**

- Reviewed by City Forester
- Removals
  - Diseased trees / Ash trees
  - Impacts from utility construction
- · Root cutting where possible
- · One-to-one replacement of all removed trees

#### **Other Boulevard Impacts**

- Driveway impacts
  - Determined by utility improvements and curb replacement
  - Saw-cutting for bituminous
  - Removal to nearest joint for concrete
- Sodding in impacted areas



### **Neighborhood Meetings**

#### August 3<sup>rd</sup> Open House

- Held at City Hall Council Chambers, approximately 9 people in attendance
- Information given on proposed improvements and schedule
- · Questions and comments taken from residents
  - · Overall not in favor of additional sidewalk or lighting
  - Questions on assessment process
  - · Questions on construction access and timing
  - · Other questions on private utilities, maintenance issues, and plowing

#### October 19th Neighborhood Meeting

- Held at City Hall Council Chambers, approximately 8 people in attendance
- Information presented on proposed improvements and schedule
- Preliminary Assessment information provided
- Questions were taken from residents
  - Questions on assessment process
  - · Questions on construction access, impacts, and timing



## Preliminary Project Funding Breakdown

| Street Light Utility Fund  | \$ 0.00                | 0.0%         |
| Street Reconstruction Fund | <u>\$ 3,443,871.00</u> | <u>29.2%</u> |
| Total                      | \$ 11,792,000.00       | 100%         |

### What impacts how much I pay in assessments?

**City Council approved assessment policy** 

### R1 & R2

- Type of street improvement
  - Partial Street reconstruction
- Assessment rate  $\rightarrow$  November 13<sup>th</sup> meeting
  - Based on construction cost index
  - DRAFT: R1 and typical R2: \$4,015 per property
    - 5.5% increase from 2023 rate
    - Approximate monthly payment: \$35 \$56
- When you pay
  - Interest rate  $\rightarrow$  November 13<sup>th</sup> meeting
  - 5.5% rate based on City bonding

### R4-R7, Commercial, & Industrial

- Project cost → Project type
- Property area
- When you pay
  - Interest rate  $\rightarrow$  November 13<sup>th</sup> meeting
  - 5.5% interest rate based on City bonding



### **Special Assessments: Payment Options**

### Payment Options:

- 1. Pay in full, or partial payment No interest between April 15 & Sept. 30, 2024
- 2. Pay in full, or partial payment, from Oct. 1 to Nov. 17, 2024 with interest from Oct. 1
- 3. Pay in installments with property taxes over a 10-year period starting in 2025, with a 5.5% interest rate
- Partial prepayments can be accepted by the City, additional information will be provided
- If the project is approved a letter will be sent to property owners for a December 2023 Assessment Hearing
